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Application Requirements & Documents to be Submitted

Application Period

- Spring Term (Enrollment in April) September 1 - November 15 of the previous year
Fall Term (Enrollment in October) March 1 - May 15 of the same year

Application Eligibility

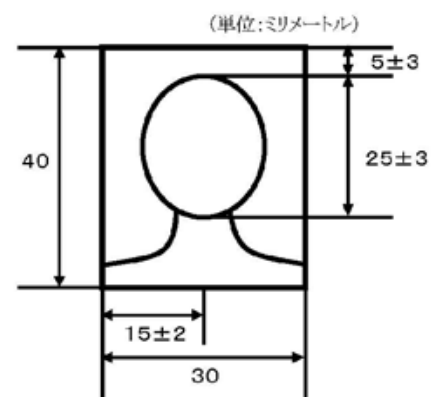
1. Persons who completed 12 years of formal junior high-level education in their own countries or abroad.
2. Persons who have a sponsor who can surely pay the tuition and the living expenses necessary for studying in Japan and who can prove the sponsor's financial statements in the form of a bank book or other documents.
3. Persons who have studied the Japanese language more than 150 hours and/or have Japanese language capability equivalent to JLPT N5 or above.

Application Documents

- B. Resume
- C. Statement of reasons for studying abroad
(to be handwritten by applicant)
- D. Photograph

Please attach seven copies of your photograph
(The photograph must have upper body without caps/hats/backgrounds and be taken within the past 3 months.)

Documents to be submitted

All documents to be submitted must be the original copies, not the photocopies except instructed as such. All certificates written in languages other than Japanese must attach their Japanese translation. Please write down the translator's name, address and telephone number in the blanks below the Japanese translation and put his/her seal on or sign to the right of the name.

B. Certification of Japanese Language Study

1. If you have passed the JLPT N5 (formally N4) or above in the past, please submit the original certificate and the original official transcripts. If you have not passed N5, please submit the original official transcripts.
2. If you have taken any Japanese language courses at a high school or a university, please submit your grades.
3. If you have attended a Japanese Language School, please submit your diploma.

C. Certification of Employment (in case you are currently employed)

B. If a family member (father, mother, husband, wife) is your financial supporter, please submit the following documents:

※ Notes on payment of tuition

- Please pay the tuition for the 2nd year before the start of the new term. The specific payment period will be notified at that time.
- In principle, the payments already made will not be refunded. However, the refund clauses stated in the School Rules may be applied.

◎Other Information

1. Part-Time Job

The students are allowed to work part-time up to 28 hours per week without disturbing their studies subject to a permission by the Regional Immigration Bureau.

2. National Health Insurance:

All international students enrolled at our school are required to buy National Health Insurance which covers 70% of the medical expenses.

◎Future Path

Our experienced teachers and staffs are willing to provide the students who desire higher education (universities, graduate schools and vocational schools) or a job with the various support such as the advices in response to the future path which each student desires. One of our support is the elective special class which is separated from the Japanese language regular courses. The students who desire higher education will learn how to deal with the electives of EJU through this class. The ones who desire a job will learn how to cope with the industry research and the job interview. Furthermore, the students will learn how to use the PCs to handle emails and Powerpoint so that they will be able to acquire more practical Japanese. In this way, we extend the generous support to the students starting from counseling about the future path at the time of the enrollment to the elective special classes for higher education or finding a job and the submission of the necessary documents after their future path is decided.
